

Case Study: Aeroworks

MCR have completed the purchase of the award winning art deco inspired Aeroworks office building in Manchester City Centre community following workspace refit



The Challenge

The building which started life as an aircraft components factory before undergoing a stylish transformation into high quality design led office space.

Aeroworks provides around 34,000 sq ft of office space and is home to a diverse mix of private and public sector tenants.

The Brief

The main aim was to keep some of the original features of the factory but fully restored so the building would have the potential for future development within its demise, with stripping back and opening the modular offices, corridors and common space. This was with the intention of creating more of a fluid, appealing, light and airy environment.



Our Solution

Workspace Design and Build presented the up-to-date office space after sandblasting and exposing steels and soffits making good use of the full height windows.

Now with high level containment, tray-work, galvanised trunking. Concrete soffits and pillars; the building has been given a neutral pallet and a modern day industrial facelift.



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
